Welcome to Third Grade !

Dear 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Students and Parents,

Reading is an important lifelong skill that we can help our students learn and practice. Summertime is a great time to maintain reading skills, improve fluency, and learn new vocabulary and concepts. Summer reading should be relaxing and fun and on topics of your child's choice. Students are required to read 3 chapter books during the summer. I encourage you to read different genres. Find one that interests you. You may choose fiction, historical fiction, fantasy, biography, mystery, or non-fiction. Attached is a **suggested** list to assist in choosing age appropriate, grade level books. (No Captain Underpants or cartoon books!)

Choose **one** of the following activities for each book:

For **each activity**, make a cover page with your name, grade, title, and author of the book.

1. Choose a birthday gift for one of the characters. Tell what the gift is and give four reasons why your character would like it.
2. Choose 5 new words you have learned. Write their definitions and a sentence for each.
3. Write a letter to one of the characters. Tell that character why you would like him/her to be your friend. Give at least 4 good reasons. Use correct friendly letter format.
4. Write a different ending to the story. Tell what happens to the characters at the end of the story.

5. Write an advertisement for your book. Try to persuade others to read it. Give 4 reasons why they should.

Remember to work neatly. Bring all of your work with you on the first day of school! Credit for your summer reading will be reflected in the first marking period homework grade.

Thank you, parents, for your support in this effort. Enjoy your reading time together and have a wonderful summer. I am looking forward to seeing you all in September.
